

#### Dear Friends,

A movie character tumbles off the cliff or out of a window, but just in time someone swoops in with an outstretched arm to lift the dangling victim to safety. In another movie the protagonists are under assault and a hero fights the attackers back with power that seems to shoot out from an outstretched arm. We don't need to name these movies, because these scenes appear frequently and are too numerous to name them all.

The image of an outstretched arm for salvation is much older than the 100+ years of movie history. Over 3,000 years ago God promised His rescue to the Israelites who suffered in slavery in Egypt: 'I am the Lord; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. (Exodus 6:6) God has always seen the pain of His creatures. He has always been filled with compassion for people who are caught in bondage. He has always been the Savior who delivers and who restores freedom. God's outstretched arm can reach beyond human restrictions. God's outstretched arm can bring back what we thought was lost forever. God's outstretched arm has all the power while our human strength falters.

It's this omnipotent arm of God that people saw in Brussels on the Global Outreach Day on May 28th in the street drama that we performed to the music of the song Set Me Free from Casting Crowns. Every time Jesus stretched out His arm the demons who had been tormenting the person in the middle that they kept in bondage of their evil schemes, dropped to the ground like dead flies. Jesus' outstretched arm is a demonstration of both His compassion and His power!

The drama ends with Jesus remaining as the only one standing in the posture of the cross with all the other actors on their knees, acknowledging Him as Lord. It's the cross where Jesus stretched out His arms. What happened wasn't weakness. It's in the outstretched arms of Jesus on the cross that we see the full extend of His love for a lost world: Both His compassion and His power to set us free! Pastorten



## ADULT BIBLE Study


Once a month we invite you to get together to discuss a Bible passage together. Just grab a cup of coffee or tea and

• Funds are Cut, New Plans are Made – As announced in church, the German partner church SELK is not continuing their contribution to our Brussels mission project. That means that a significant part of our budget is cut and we have to change gears. Pastor will move to a different congregation by summer next year. The church board with the Pastors van Hattem (Antwerp) Tepper and Reitze-Landau (Brussels) are working on plans to continue our spiritual home at ALCB.

• G.O.D. – Millions of Christians shared their faith on the Global Outreach Day on May 28. In Brussels about 1,000 people saw the Gospel drama and we connected with dozens in friendly conversations. Read testimonies about in on www.globaloutreachday.com

• European Lutheran Conference (ELC) – Antwerp was host of the ELC with sister churches and guests from 1-5 June. Part of it was the commemoration of 450 years of Lutheran Church in the "Lower Countries" (Nether-lands and Belgium). This is organized by our church in collaboration with the University of Antwerp on 2-3 June with speakers from home and abroad.
